Through paperbark collected from the environment around her, wire mesh, string lights and spray-paint, she has created a visual representation of the pain and suffering that occurs to both people and nature. Alyssa's work stands one-metre-tall and is a worthy winner of the SIDE Principal's Art Award 2018.
