Three words that describe me are good, great and magnificent.


My plans for 2019 are to get myself an electrical apprenticeship and start an Electrics TAFE course.

Three words that describe me are shy, funny and positive.


My plans for 2019 are go to TAFE to become a hairdresser/make-up artist.
