Success at SIDE

To ensure success at SIDE, home-based students require:

a dedicated SIDE supervisor who will:

- actively communicate with SIDE teachers and the relevant Student Coordinator
- support the student with their day-to-day studies
- ensure that the student submits their completed work according to SIDE course and assessment outlines
- please note that an additional SIDE and/or School Curriculum and Standards Authority test/examination supervisor may be required

access to a quiet and well-equipped learning environment, including:

- an internet connection that is as fast and reliable as possible
- PC or laptop computers (including BYOD devices). PCs/Laptops should run Windows 11 or Apple Mac (OS version 10.15 or above). Other devices such as iPads, Windows 10S, Android tablets and Chromebooks will not fully function with our online teaching platforms
- software installed on the computer should include an up-to-date web browser (Microsoft Edge is recommended), and Adobe Reader or equivalent. Microsoft Office is provided
- USB headsets with microphones
- a webcam
- access to:
 - a printer
 - a scanner or digital camera or mobile phone and data storage
 - a phone

Learning at SIDE

SIDE teachers are in regular communication with students and parents/caregivers/supervisors. SIDE uses two main platforms for teaching and learning.



Webex is the SIDE platform for live, online lessons. Lesson timetables will be provided to students after enrolment.



Moodle is SIDE's 24/7 learning management system where students complete work independently, under the direction and guidance of their teachers.
