## Success at SIDE

Schools enrolling students at SIDE can support their students for success by:

providing a dedicated SIDE supervisor and point of contact at their school who will:

- communicate and collaborate with SIDE teachers
- actively support students as they participate in live lessons and with work
- communicate relevant base-school information (eg term calendars).

ensuring access to an appropriate learning environment with an internet connection as fast and reliable as possible.

Where students are using individual devices:

- PC or laptop computers (including) BYOD devices). PCs/Laptops should run Windows 11 or Apple Mac (OS version 10.15 or above). Other devices such as iPads, Windows 10S, Android tablets and Chromebooks will not fully function with our online teaching platforms
- software installed on the computer should include an up-to-date web browser (Microsoft Edge is recommended)
- USB headsets with microphones
- a webcam

Where whole-class lessons are delivered:

- large screen device with speakers, and PC/laptop connection with access to an up-to-date web browser
- an wide-angle webcam
- an echo-cancelling microphone

Students may need access to a printer and scanner.
