The artwork advocates for a more compassionate approach to education and a redefinition of success that prioritizes personal growth and well-being.

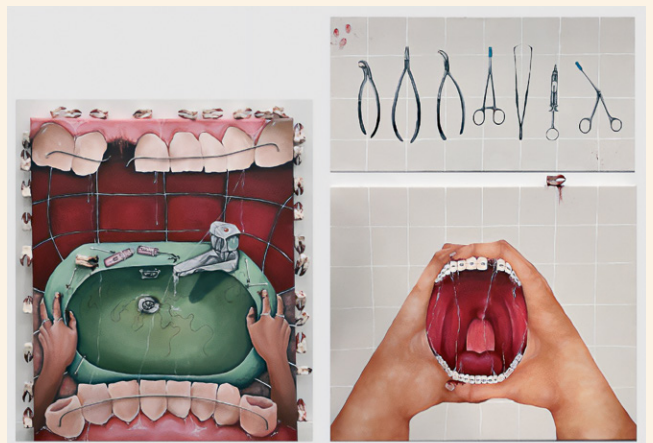


## LILY STOCKS

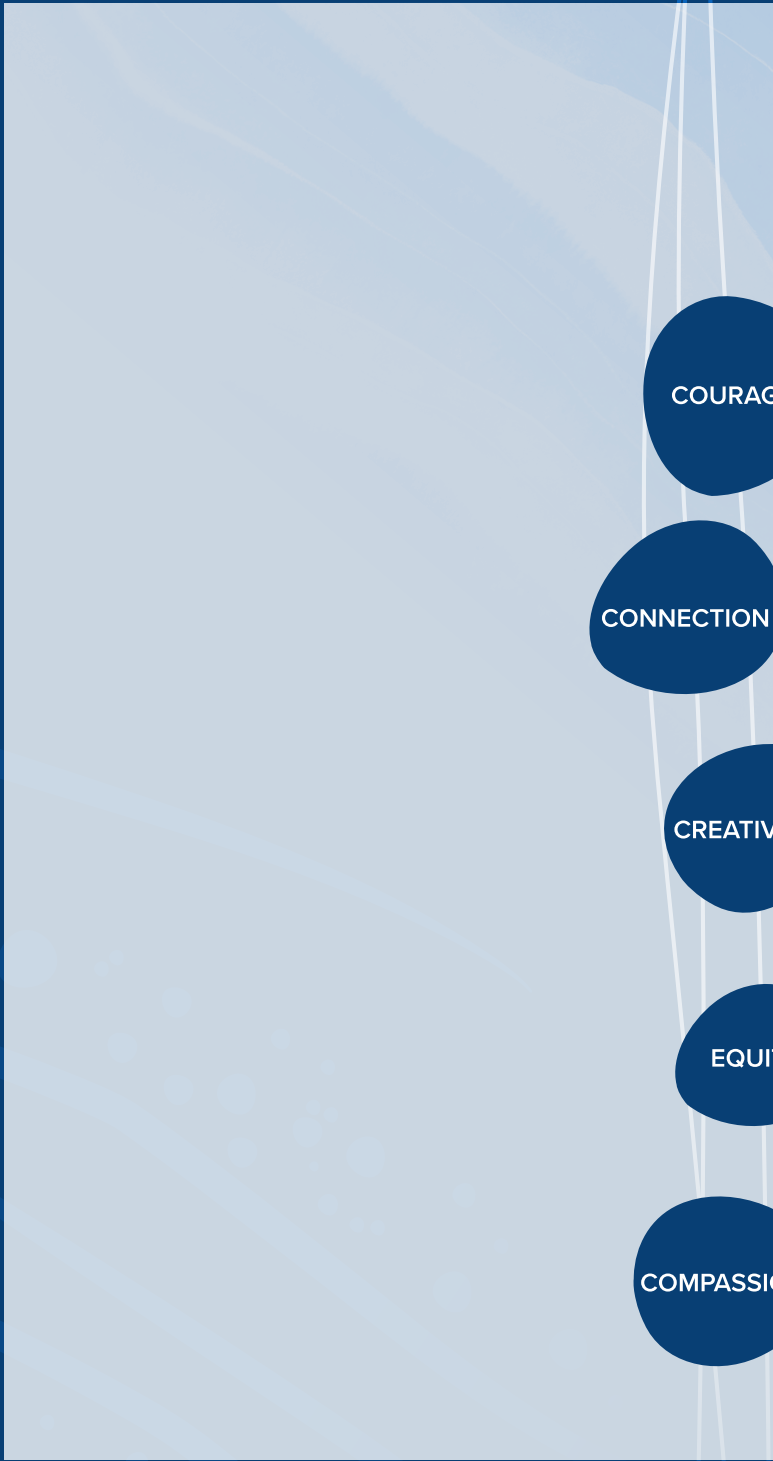
