I have been enrolled at SIDE Primary for two years because I've been travelling around Australia in a Big Purple Bus.


The three best things I like about being at SIDE Primary are:




I have been enrolled at SIDE Primary for one year because my family and I are travelling around Australia.

I have been enrolled at SIDE Primary for six months because I have an immune condition that makes me very ill and it is difficult to attend a bricks and mortar school.


I like being at SIDE Primary because:
