- Britannica School

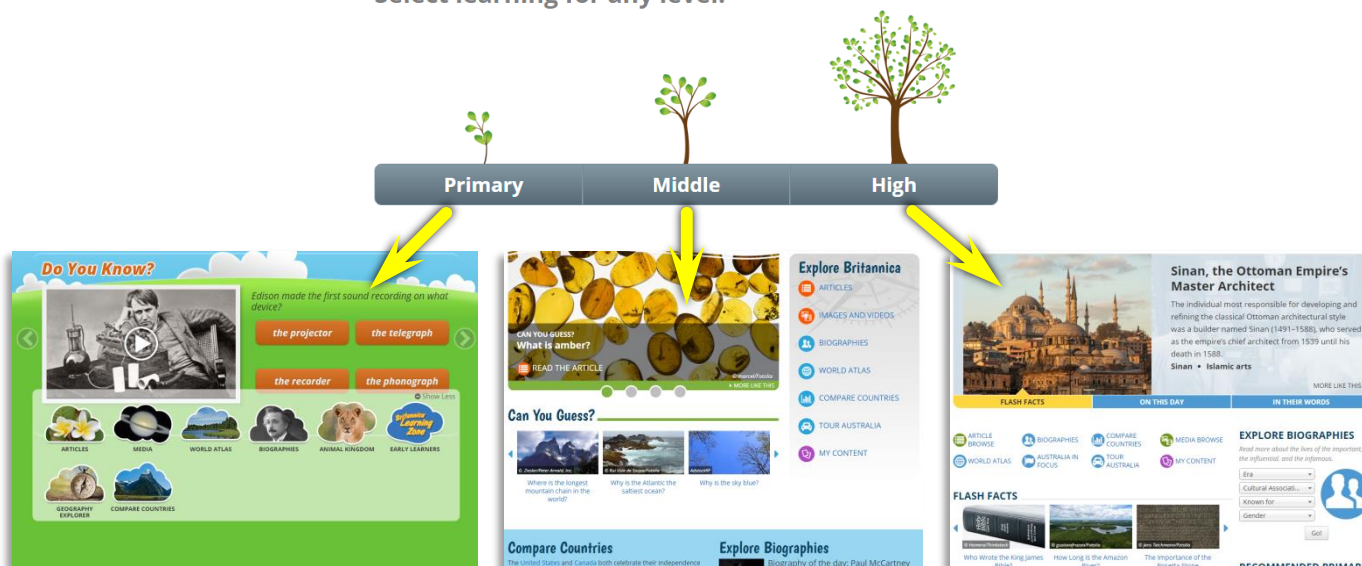


### 2. Select the appropriate encyclopaedia version for you:
