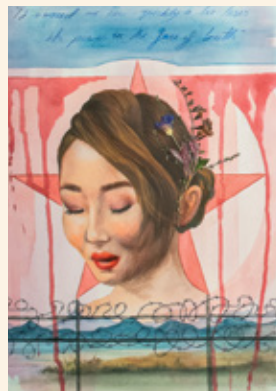
We are so proud of you all. Congratulations on your completion of Year 12.

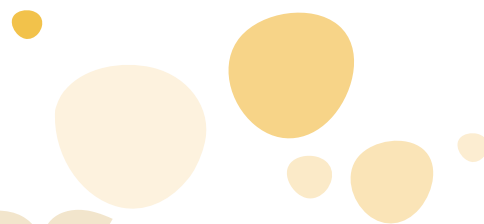

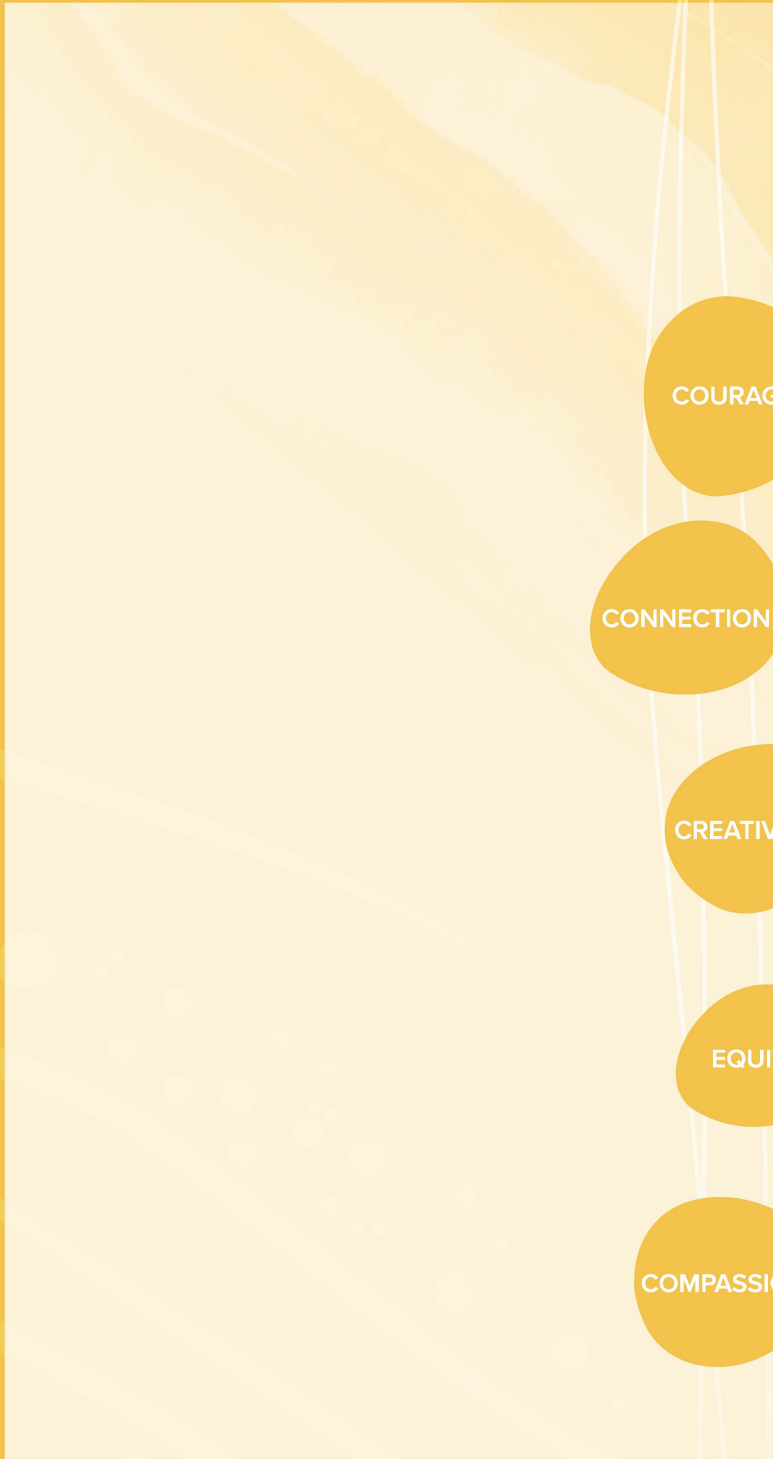
