- Be flexible, some rules may need to be added and others deleted.

The following School Rules were created by a SIDE family.

Rule	What it looks like
Sharing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share belongings.• Ask if you can borrow another’s belongings.
Cooperation/Team work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Work together.• Work out problems together.
Thoughtfulness/Consideration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consider others.• Clean up after yourself.• Be quiet when Mum/Dad asks.
Honesty	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be honest with each other.• If unsure of things that happen, discuss with Mum and Dad
Determination	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do your best.• Try even when things are hard.
Respect	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mum and Dad.• Complete all requests with “please”.
Responsibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take responsibility for getting ready in the morning by 8 am.
