My personal interests are gaming, anything animal related (*especially having to do with dogs*) and cooking.

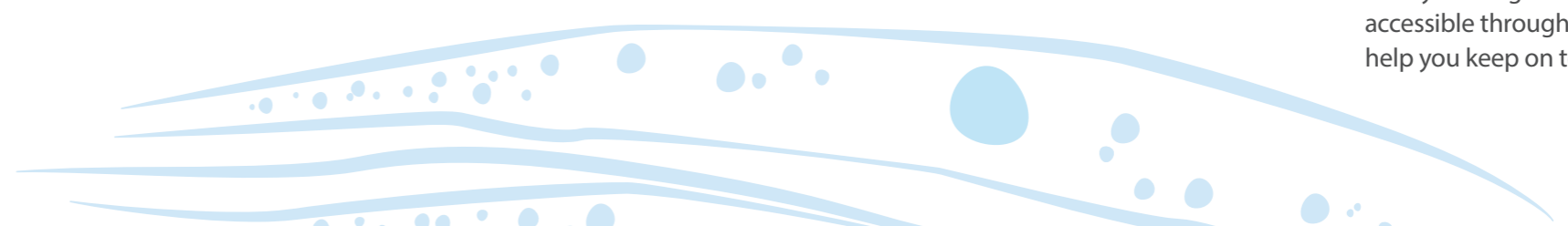
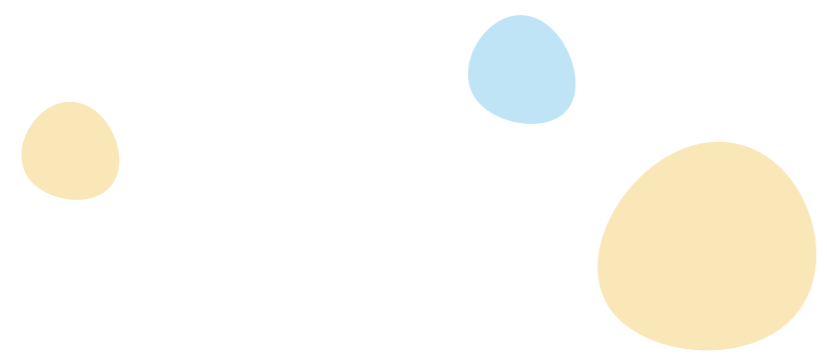
Three words that describe me are curious, ambitious and passionate.

### Artist's Statement:

Everyone has their own ideas about love, what they see as ideal, and what they want in love.

These people then put these ideals onto others without a partner, and pressure them to have the same views, telling them what they should look for in a person.

Our society is also heavily focused on the idea of our perfect other half, our soulmate, and we feel pressured to find this person.

I decided to represent this meaning through the concept of 'the red thread of fate' which is a thread that connects you to your soulmate and is a symbol of love.

The painting uses hands as symbols of the different ideals and expectations people have of love, and the red thread represents the action of putting these expectations on to others.

I connected these red threads to a singular white hand that represents the viewer, showing the amount of pressure these expectations can have on one person.

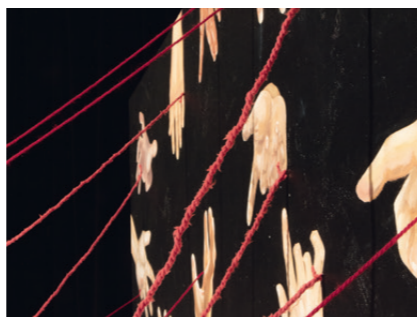
The hand is also white to show a lack of bias, so no matter the skin tone, the viewer can identify with it.

I created my piece using ceramic clay for the 3D hand sculpture, painting it white with acrylic paint. I added yarn and red poly cotton twisted to make string to suggest the red thread of fate.

The painting of the hands was created with oil paint on canvas, first primed with a white gesso, later covered in black gesso, giving the illusion that the hands are coming from the darkness, creating emphasis on the hands as they contrast the minimalistic background.

There is only one hand to show that the person does not yet have a partner. Therefore, they're a victim of society's pressures on love, which is shown by the numerous threads connecting to it.
