

My personal interests are drawing, playing guitar/ukulele, creative writing, reading and music.







LIVING MANTLE BY AMARA SINCLAIR-HILL



To mantle something is to cloak and/or envelop it. It can also allude to a role that is assumed. As humans in the twenty first century, we have inherited the Earth as our mantle. It is our responsibility to care for it.

Our relationship to Nature's mantle is varied and evolving. In this painting, I have represented it as a dynamic symbiosis on the left panel, moving through a cloak of farmland in the centre contrasted with a more parasitic connection on the right.


I have explored loose allusions to the passage of time (looking forward to the future, living in and staring the present in the face) and eventual mortality

The most important artistic influence in this piece is the work of Gustav Klimt, particularly his integration of detailed patterns into symbolic portraiture. Another visual influence was the toxic jungle in Hayao Miyazaki's film *Nausicaa of the valley of the wind*, a narrative centring around the human relationship with nature, it is almost dystopian in its representation of an extremely polluted world.

I used Google Earth to craft the network of roots in the left panel based upon the network of rivers and roads in the area within which I spent my childhood - my own personal roots.

As a young person who has grown up in the forests that my parents campaigned to save, I have a great appreciation for the natural world. The looming global threat of climate change and urbanisation intertwine with my personal plans to move to the city soon to begin my adult life. These transitions make me worried about my own personal connection to nature - and for humanity as a whole.

LEGACIES BY SIENNA BERRY



As a contemporary youth, I have experienced great uncertainty regarding the future. A particular focus of my anxieties is environmental degradation and the current trajectory of fauna and flora extinctions. For *Legacies* I sought to encapsulate an ecocritical point of view on pollution and non-renewability. The ocean is often viewed as the origin of life, and if humanity continues to pursue unsustainability it may well become devoid of it, with only the permanent remnants of our presence remaining.

Ideas were explored in the form of thumbnail sketches. I identified overfishing, plastic pollution and fossil fuels as my issues of focus. My three subjects were children of whom I have a close relationship with: my neighbour, friend, and brother. My selected medium was acrylic paint on canvas as the fast-drying aspect and blendability was desirable. The style of portraiture is realism, and my technique was highly influenced by Baroque artists and Josh Keyes, as shown through the high tonal contrast and saturated primary colours. Similar themes of isolation and dystopia are also explored in my piece, as influenced by Keyes.

The subjects' pained faces are presented as hierarchically significant to invoke an empathetic response. The human psyche is often incapable of visualising large statistics; thus, the significance of pollution figures is not fully realised by the public. To combat this, I drew on the intense emotions I experience when visually confronted by photographs of suffering marine animals. My intent was to invoke a similar emotional reaction in my audience, who is of an adult demographic, by substituting animals with children. The purpose of this was to urge the audience to reconsider their own practices and contemplate what they want the world to look like for future generations. Will our legacies be our children or our ecological footprints?


